COWPOKE COURSE CLASSES – courses designed with basic to intermediate obstacles encountered on mountain trails, a working ranch, or trail competition. <i>Professional riders/trainers (anyone that receives remuneration) may not enter classes 2-10.</i>		
1	LIL WRANGLERS (13 & Under) - Leading by an adult is acceptable and scored accordingly.	\$25
2	JUNIOR RANCH HAND (14-17)	\$35
3	ADULT RANCH HAND (18-49)	\$35
4	OLD TIMERS (50 & over)	\$35
5	RANCH HORSE (Novice Horse) - Horse has limited experience showing and/or training for this type of an event and has not placed in the top 2 of any trail class or event more than 3 times.	\$35
6	RANCH HAND (Novice Rider) - Rider has limited experience showing and/or training for this type of an event and has not placed in the top 2 of any trail class or event more than 3 times.	\$35
7	RANCH MARE	\$35
8	RANCH GELDING/STALLION	\$35
9	RANCH STOCK HORSE - Quarter Horse, Paint, Appaloosa and horses of similar style.	\$35
10	COUNTRY PLEASURE HORSE - Arabian, Morgan, Saddlebred and horses of similar type.	\$35
11	TENDERFOOT (Newcomer) - An introduction for the beginning horse and rider of any age and/or discipline that are experimenting or just learning about mountain trail shows/events for the very first time.	\$35
12	JUNIOR RANCH HORSE - 3 & 4 yrs old horses.	\$35
13	OPEN RANCH HORSE - All riders and horses.	\$35

14	Purchase score sheet and course map, hand it to the judge, complete the course and be scored/evaluated (which may include feedback/comments). This class has no draw order, just check in with judge during the designated time.	\$5

COWBOY COURSE CLASSES - designed with intermediate to advanced obstacles encountered on mountain trails, a working ranch, or trail competition. These are 3-day classes whereby each entrant will have one go each day. Scores from each day will be accumulated to determine final placing.		
15	WORKING RANCH HAND (NOVICE RIDER) - Exhibitor has limited experience showing and/or training for this type of an event and has not placed in the top 2 of any trail class or event more than 5 times.	\$120
16	WORKING RANCH HORSE (NOVICE HORSE) - Horse has limited experience showing and/or training for this type of an event and has not placed in the top 2 of any trail class or event more than 5 times.	\$120
17	WORKING COWBOY (NON-PRO) - Exhibitors that have experience on mountain trails, a working ranch, and/or engage in this activity as a pastime/hobby/sport, rather than a profession. This class is NOT for exhibitors/competitors who have taken remuneration for training, instruction, giving lessons, clinics, etc...	\$150
18	WORKING COWBOY (PRO) – Open to all exhibitors.	\$150
19	BUCKAROO (Timed & Judged) - Exhibitors are judged for accuracy of execution - completed in the quickest amount of timed.	\$100

ALL AROUND RANCH HAND (Arena Work) - Must also be entered in the open or non-pro and the timed & judged event to ride in this class for the all around horsemanship title.

If entered in both the non-pro and the open classes, you will need to designate (prior to the first class on the first day) which class you want to use towards all around. The same horse/rider combination has to be used for all three classes.

21	PONY EXPRESS RACE - This class is a timed & judged relay race performed in teams of 3 horses and riders. Each rider will run a separate mapped trail course as quickly as they can carrying a mail bag to a designated point where its passed between riders on the run until each rider has carried the mail bag through their assigned section of the trail course.	\$90 Team of 3 riders
